1 Title

This notice is the KiwiSaver Default Provider (AMP) Revocation Notice 2015.

2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on 22 September 2015.

3 Application

This notice applies to AMP Services (NZ) Limited.

4 Interpretation

In this notice, unless the context requires otherwise—

principal notice means the KiwiSaver Default Provider (AMP) Notice 2014 dated 16 April 2014.

5 Revocation

The principal notice is revoked.

Explanatory Note

This note is for explanatory purposes only.

The KiwiSaver Default Provider (AMP) Notice 2014 dated 16 April 2014 is revoked by this notice. AMP Services (NZ) Limited provided notice, under clause 18(1)(a) of the KiwiSaver Default Provider (AMP) Notice 2014, that they wished to cease acting as a default provider. On 22 September 2015 AMP Wealth Management New Zealand Limited was appointed as a KiwiSaver default provider under the KiwiSaver Default Provider (AMP) Notice 2015. The revocation of the KiwiSaver Default Provider (AMP) Notice 2014 and the subsequent appointment of AMP Wealth Management New Zealand Limited as a default provider is a consequence of a transition to a single manager within AMP.
