YOUR REQUEST FOR INFORMATION UNDER THE OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT 1982

We refer to your request made on 13 June 2018 to the Financial Markets Authority (FMA) under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA).

You have requested:

- 1. A copy of FMA's policy for staff accepting gifts and/or hospitality
- 2. A copy of FMA's policy for Board members accepting gifts and/or hospitality
- 3. A list of any gifts or hospitality accepted by staff since 1 July 2016
- 4. A list of any gifts or hospitality accepted by Board members since 1 July 2016

You have noted in your request that your particular interest is in anything received from entities which FMA is involved in regulating, or from professional advisers of any such entities.

The shaded entries in the table above relate to gifts or hospitality received from market participants.

Please note that the personal information of the recipient and the party giving gifts or hospitality have been removed on the basis of the following grounds under the OIA:

- s9(2)(a) that withholding of the information is necessary to protect the privacy of natural persons.
- s9(2)(b)(ii) that withholding of the information is necessary to protect information where the making available of the information would be likely unreasonably to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied or who is the subject of the information.

In respect of the information to which the grounds for withholding apply on the basis of ss9(2)(a) and 9(2)(b)(ii) of the OIA, we do not consider there to be other considerations which render it desirable, in the public interest, to make the information available.

As for 2 above, FMA Board approves and endorses FMA's Sensitive Expenditure and Gifts Policy as recommended by the State Services Commission.¹ FMA also has guidelines for Board members on conflicts of interest under which if members are in any doubt as to whether an interest arises in relation to a particular matter they should raise the matter with the chairperson.

As for 4 above, there is no gift or hospitality accepted by the Board members since 1 July 2016.

We note that you have a right by way of complaint under section 28(3) of the OIA to the Ombudsman, to seek an investigation and review of the FMA's decision to refuse to provide the information requested.
